About Habitat for Humanity North Central Georgia

Habitat for Humanity North Central Georgia (Habitat-NCG) is a nonprofit, qualified tax exempt Christian housing ministry that works together in partnership with people from all walks of life to build houses for, and with, families in need of simple, decent and affordable housing. The Habitat homeownership program is open to all people, regardless of race, religion, color or creed.

Habitat-NCG is an affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International. We are independent and locally run. We are responsible for our own funding, family selection and education, land acquisition and development, and home construction. Habitat NCG's service area includes North Fulton, Cherokee, Forsyth and Dawson counties.

The year 2010 was one of celebration for us. It marked our **15th anniversary** and to make this celebration even more special, construction of home 200 was completed in Forsyth and home 201 in Cherokee. Construction and dedication of 4 additional homes was completed in a 29-townhome development in Milton, GA on December 11, 2010. As of June 2011, we have built 214 homes in the Habitat-NCG service area, providing the benefits and blessings of homeownership for over approximately 800 family members.

We are grateful to God and to you, our supporters, that we have been able to extend "a hand-up and not a hand out" to these families as they begin to live the American Dream of successful homeownership.
